How to **Fast Track** Your High School Diploma

With a combination of prior high school credits, accelerated online courses, test out opportunities and the CHS 18-credit career diploma framework, you can significantly reduce the time it takes you to earn your high school diploma.



The “Fast Track” Approach:

1. Send your previous high school transcript to CHS as soon as possible.
2. Sign up for a [30-minute consultation call](#) with a CHS Admissions Specialist to review your transcript and create your “fast track” work and learn graduation pathway
3. Follow the guided pathway you develop with your Admissions Specialist to complete your diploma
4. CHS advises focusing on only taking one or two courses at a time for the best results

While most high schools require 22 or more credits to graduate, CHS’s Career Diploma requires only 18 credits. This allows many students to graduate up to a year earlier than traditional pathways. For those of you that can, think of high school as three years not four.

Lay out a **flexible pathway** to complete your degree

After you receive your transcript evaluation and the list of remaining courses, you can now plan how long it will take you to graduate, and in what order you would like to take your courses. Your timeline to graduation depends on your available time, the number of remaining courses, and your elective choices.

“Your high school pathway should fit you, not the other way around”

CHS has several course learning options that are flexible and adaptable to meet your life’s schedule, such as....

1. Online Learning: CHS online courses are available 24/7
2. Each course has flexible timelines for completion.
You can binge learn, normal learn or slowly learn. All courses are set up for 16 weeks, but you have the option to complete the course requirements as quickly as 4 weeks or take as long as 20 weeks. You work at your own pace.
3. CHS offers over 150 elective courses and several directed studied courses where the course content can be tailored to the needs of the student, such as: Directed Reading, Life Skills, Cooking, and many others.

For Example

Directed Reading allows a student to read any three books of their choice in a subject area of their interest so long as they meet the course requirements. **(Read 3 books in 4 months and earn 1 credit)**

Life Skills and Cooking courses enable you to collaborate with instructors to tailor outcomes that fit your interests and goals.

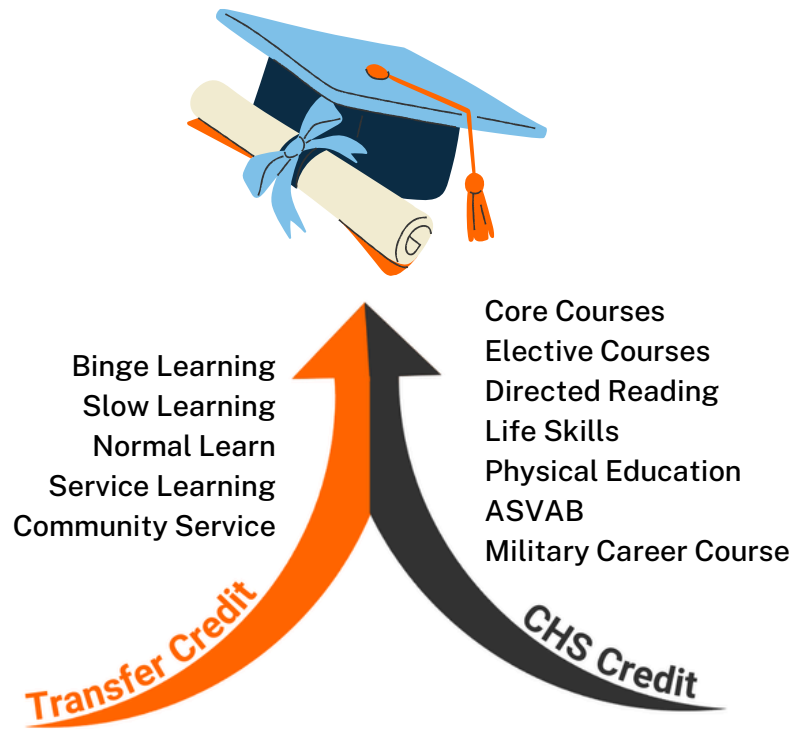
