THREE PATHS A MILITARY FAMILY CAN CONSIDER



01

STAY WITH THE CURRENT SCHOOL

If your teen is on track and the current plan works, changing schools now may not be necessary.

MAY MAKE SENSE WHEN

- Required courses are available
- Graduation requirements are clear
- Another move remains uncertain

No change may be the right choice. A review simply helps your family compare before orders arrive.

ADD ONE OR MORE CHS COURSES

Your teen can remain at the current school and use an individual CHS course to fill a course or credit gap.

A GOOD FIT WHEN

- A required course is unavailable or full
- There is a schedule conflict
- A missing credit could delay graduation

Get approval first. The current school decides whether and how an individual CHS course will apply.



03

CHOOSE A COMPLETE CHS DIPLOMA PROGRAM

A complete CHS diploma can provide one school of record and one graduation plan through repeated moves.

BUILT FOR CONTINUITY

- Continue with the same school after a PCS move
- Keep one official CHS transcript
- Choose an 18-credit Career or 24-credit College pathway

Start with a review. CHS evaluates prior records before building a complete diploma plan.

PLAN BEFORE THE NEXT SCHOOL TRANSITION

A free transcript review can show what may transfer, what remains, and which path may fit without requiring enrollment.



YOUR FOUR-STEP ACTION PLAN

1

SEND THE TRANSCRIPT

A current or unofficial copy is enough for the first review.

2

SHARE WHAT MAY CHANGE

Tell us the expected move window and the school concerns you already see.

3

COMPARE THREE PATHS

Stay enrolled, add selected CHS courses, or consider a full diploma program.

4

CHOOSE BEFORE THE MOVE

Know the next step before a new schedule creates an urgent deadline.

A COMMON MILITARY FAMILY SCENARIO

Orders may arrive next spring.

The current school works today, but the teen is entering 11th grade and another duty station may not offer the courses needed to stay on schedule.

WHAT A CHS REVIEW MAY SHOW

CHS can map three options now: make no change, add an approved course if a gap appears, or move into a complete diploma program. The family leaves with a plan before the next schedule creates an emergency.

A FREE REVIEW DOES NOT REQUIRE ENROLLMENT. IT GIVES YOUR FAMILY A PLAN.

COMPARE THE OPTIONS BEFORE THE MOVE

Send the transcript and share what may change. Admissions will explain possible course and diploma options so your family can make an informed decision.
