TWO WAYS CHS MAY HELP

TAKE ONLY THE COURSE YOUR STUDENT NEEDS

Your student may stay enrolled at the current or receiving school while completing an individual CHS course online.

A GOOD FIT WHEN

- A required course is unavailable or full
- School calendars or semester dates do not match
- A missing credit or schedule conflict could delay graduation

Before enrolling: ask the receiving school to approve the CHS course. That school determines whether the credit will be accepted.

CONTINUE WITH ONE CONSISTENT DIPLOMA PLAN

When repeated moves or changing requirements disrupt graduation planning, a complete CHS diploma pathway may provide continuity.

BUILT FOR CONTINUITY

- Continue online after the next duty-station move
- Keep one school, one academic record, and one graduation plan
- Explore an 18-credit Career or 24-credit College diploma pathway

Start with a transcript review. Admissions compares completed credits with the student's goals before recommending a pathway.

A free transcript review turns uncertainty into clear next steps before your family has to make an enrollment decision.



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YOUR FOUR-STEP ACTION PLAN

SEND THE TRANSCRIPT

Current or unofficial is fine.

2

LET CHS REVIEW

We identify completed credits, current courses, and possible gaps.

3

COMPARE THE OPTIONS

One course, several courses, or a full diploma pathway.

4

CHOOSE WHAT WORKS

Understand the options before deciding how to move forward.

A MIDYEAR EXAMPLE

Orders arrive in October.

The new school does not offer a required course until January, putting the semester and possibly graduation timing at risk.

HOW CHS MAY HELP

CHS reviews the transcript and course need. After receiving-school approval, the student may be able to begin online without automatically losing the semester.

Do not wait for the withdrawal date. An earlier review gives your family more options.
