01

HELP MEET THE EDUCATION REQUIREMENT

CHS provides an accredited high school diploma pathway and an official transcript. The recruiter and service branch make all final decisions about enlistment eligibility and education classification.



02

BUILD A REALISTIC GRADUATION PLAN

Admissions reviews previous credits, identifies what remains, and compares the 18-credit Career and 24-credit College pathways. The family sees the academic plan before deciding how to proceed.



03

ALIGN SCHOOL WITH THE MILITARY TIMELINE

CHS considers the target graduation date, recruiter timeline, ASVAB plans, and anticipated training or ship date when known. This helps the family understand whether the proposed timeline is realistic.



04

PROVIDE PROOF OF ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Available records may include enrollment verification, progress documentation, a Will Graduate Letter for eligible enrolled seniors, and an official CHS transcript after courses or graduation are completed.

CHS HANDLES THE EDUCATION PLAN

Credits, coursework, progress, and official school records.

THE RECRUITER HANDLES ENLISTMENT

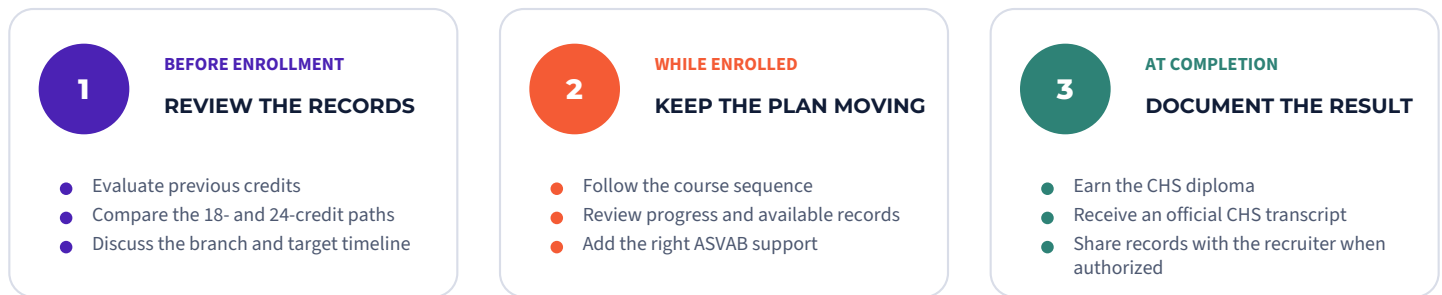
Eligibility, testing minimums, processing, contracts, and service requirements.
